

# 3S OPTIMIZER SETTINGS GUIDE

## Parameters

Trade Setups : Indicates whether to look for long, short, or both setups

Trade Size : how many units/contracts to test

Break Even Level Relative to Entry : specifies when breakeven should be triggered ; ie a setting of 100 means that price should reach 100% of TP1 before breakeven is triggered

Take Profit Percent at Profit Target 1: specifies how much of position should be taken off when TP 1 is hit ; ie a setting of 50 means that 50% of the position will be taken off when TP1 is hit

## Strategy Filters

Enable Close above/below EMAs filter - specifies that trades will only be taken if price is above EMA for a long; or trades will only be taken if price is below EMA for a short ; this filter can be enabled or disabled

Enable Fast EMA above/below Slow EMA filter - specifies that trades will only be taken if the fast EMA has crossed above slow EMA for a long; or trades will only be taken if price the fast EMA has crossed below the slow EMA for a short; this filter can be enabled or disabled

Enable Min Distance to TP1 filter - specifies it will only enter into a position if there is enough 'space' to TP1 - remember that trades are considered on close only - if the trade is too close to TP1, trade will be avoided ; ie a value of 75 means that a trade will be avoided if less than 75% towards TP1 is left ; this filter can be enabled or disabled

Min Distance to Trend EMA in % relative to TP1 - specifies whether a trade will be taken or avoided depending on distance from entry to trend EMA; ie a value of 250 means that the trend EMA must at least 250% away from entry price to consider trade; if less than 250, trade will be avoided; a value of 100 would be equal to TP1 ; this filter can be enabled or disabled

Fast EMA period - specifies your fast EMA setting

Slow EMA period - specifies your slow EMA setting

Trend EMA period - specifies your trend EMA setting
